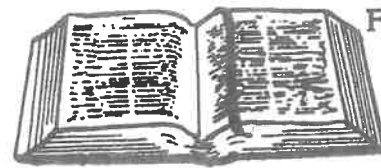

IN THE YEAR OF THE LORD - 2025

The Year In Review

It was a "Year of our Lord" for St. John, as His presence was evident in so many ways.

2025 WAS FOR ST. JOHN, A YEAR OF:

- + Resigned to the nearly impossible task of securing an organist, and with the advantage of the array of available music, we have continued our practice of using "Digital Music" for our worship services and funerals. Pastor selects, locates, downloads, edits, normalizes for volume, and prepares audio files from various sources and then transfers them onto a lap-top, hooked into our sound system for our "Digital Organists" to play during the service. A sizable and time-consuming task, but one which has resulted in a wide variety of music selections.
- + We are into our second year using our newest ministry item within the church, a wall mounted 85" large screen monitor. Every worship service now presents "Welcome Pictures". A welcome to St. John image, leads to carefully selected images that reveal the theme of the day and are designed to depict and enhance the spoken content of the day's sermon. – The ability to conduct a slide-show presentation has also been used for special sermons, funerals and the school tours of our church and cemetery.
- + Our neighbor: "Mount Prospect Senior Living" underwent a change of ownership to: "American House". New staff and leadership provided a lack of support for Pastor's monthly Devotional Bible Classes already in late 2024, which ended this ministry for 2025.
- + Historical tours of our church and cemetery continued for two Mt. Prospect elementary schools. Over a month, 300+ students, teachers and parents attended these tours. MP School District 57 produced in their media a "Thank You" to Pastor for his years of conducting these tours, complete with color pictures taken during the tours.
- + Additional improvements were made to the lower level of our 1101 Building. The hallways, kitchen, restrooms, and Bible Study Room were professionally painted. Thanks to Joe Schubkegel, who also installed new lighting fixtures in the hallways and restrooms; and to Jan Anderko, who added "the woman's touch" to enhance the restroom's looks.
- + What started in 2024, continued throughout 2025, with a sizable number of returning visitors for worship and Bible Class every Sunday. And we welcomed those who joined our St. John Family.
- + The year 2025 also brought much more personal sadness than usual, as we lost some very loved Family members through death. Seven of our members were welcomed into Heaven. Their contributions to our congregation will be remembered and greatly missed.
- + So many other day to day tasks, varied ministries, challenges and prayers were faced by your Pastor and your church leaders in 2025.
- + Our leaders, board members, our St. John Family members and many willing volunteers worked together to keep the ministries of our church going. We are grateful to everyone who aided, assisted and supported St John during this past year.

It was a year of joys and sorrows, Bible classes, meetings, special worship services, programs and ministries and countless blessings from our Lord. It was all of this and more, for 2025 was a: "Year of our Lord" at St. John.
